## Contact partners with Women in Geothermal (WING) to promote diversity in the geothermal industry.

Contact Energy, one of New Zealand's largest generator/retail energy companies, is excited to partner with Women in Geothermal (WING), to encourage women to join the geothermal community both in New Zealand and around the world.

Women are significantly underrepresented in the geothermal industry, particularly at leadership levels. The geothermal community currently has a female employment level of just over a 15% (ESMAP, 2018).

Contact has entered into an Advance Global Partnership with WING and is one of two Global Partners. The Advance Global Partnership aims to advance women in the geothermal industry and get them ready for more challenging senior roles. By encouraging women into leadership roles WING and Contact expect to see positive benefits for the geothermal community.
