Contact Energy has today announced the appointment of Tighe Wall, Contact's Chief Digital Officer, to the new role of Chief Technology Officer.

This new role brings together Contact's Digital and ICT functions.

Commenting about the appointment CEO Mike Fuge said he was excited about the opportunities the approach would bring as the company continued to grow and deliver in the renewable energy transition.

This included leading ICT's recent award-winning Enterprise Architecture approach, Contact's move to Cloud which reduced cost-to-serve, building strong cyber security foundations, and the successful SAP ERP upgrade to S/4HANA," said Mr Fuge.

"Iain is fully supportive of this organisational change and is going to take the opportunity to explore career options in both New Zealand and overseas."
